(U) Executive Summary

(U) Scope

(U) The Worldwide Threat to Shipping (WTS) report provides information on threats to merchant vessels, the shipping industry, and other maritime stakeholders worldwide in the last 30 days. This report is produced primarily to inform merchant mariners and naval forces.

(U) WEST AFRICA – GULF OF GUINEA

1. (U) **IVORY COAST:** On 29 May at 0004 local time, there was a robbery on an Antigua and Barbuda offshore supply vessel while anchored at Abidjan inner anchorage.
(Closed/Clearwater Dynamics)

(U) EAST ASIA – SOUTHEAST ASIA



1. ****LATE REPORT** (U) MANILA:** On 12 June, a robbery occurred onboard a Marshall Islands-flagged container vessel while at anchor at Manila North Port Anchorage. The crew spotted six perpetrators onboard and raised the alarm. The robbers escaped with items from the ship's stores, all crew members reported safe. (IFC/Clearwater Dynamics)
2. (U) **MANILA (U):** On 19 June at 0035 local time, a robbery occurred onboard a Marshall Islands-flagged container vessel while at anchor off MICT Anchorage. The crew spotted the perpetrators on board and raised the alarm. The robbers escaped with stolen ship's stores and equipment, all crew members reported safe. (IFC/Clearwater Dynamics)
3. (U) **SINGAPORE STRAIT:** On 13 June at 0503 local time, an attempted robbery occurred onboard a bulk carrier while underway in the Phillip Channel. The vessel's crew reported the perpetrators upon spotting them, all crew members reported safe. (IFC/Clearwater Dynamics)

4. **(U) PHILIPPINES:** On 03 June at 2015 UTC, an armed robbery occurred on board a container ship while anchored in Manila Anchorage. Four perpetrators armed with guns and a knife held the duty watchman captive and forced him to open the bosun's store. The perpetrators tied the watchman's hands with rope then escaped with the ship's stores, all crew members reported safe. (IMB/Clearwater Dynamics)

(U) PERSIAN GULF

1. **(U) PERSIAN GULF:** On 01 June at 1300 central time, there was an attack on a cargo ship while underway approximately 40NM southeast of Umn Qasr, Iraq. The vessel reported an explosion followed by a hit from an unknown projectile. UKMTO reported a second impact to the cargo vessel resulting in a fire, which has been extinguished. No reported injuries or casualties. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
2. **(U) GULF OF ADEN:** On 28 May at 1930 central time, a tanker was approached by a skiff while underway IVO Yemen. The skiff came as close as 3NM of the vessel. The tanker conducted evasive maneuvers and the vessel's armed security team was deployed to the bridge wing. The vessel mustered the crew and a VHF notification was issued by the tanker to surrounding vessels. (MASTER OF VESSEL/Clearwater Dynamics)

(U) INDIAN OCEAN – EAST AFRICA – RED SEA

NAVAL INTELLIGENCE

1. **(U) GULF OF ADEN:** On 21 June at 1319 UTC, an attempted boarding occurred to a tanker while underway 50NM southeast of Yemen. A skiff carrying five-armed perpetrators attempted to board the tanker. The tanker conducted evasive maneuvers and the skiff broke off. All crew members reported safe. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
2. **(U) GULF OF ADEN:** On 17 June at 1610 UTC, a vessel was fired upon by two skiffs with an unknown number of armed perpetrators onboard while underway 105NM southeast of Aden. The vessel's security team was deployed and an exchange of fire occurred, one crew member was injured during the incident. (UKMTO/CLOSED/Clearwater Dynamics)
3. **(U) GULF OF ADEN:** On 15 June at 1350 UTC, a Panama-flagged tanker was attacked by four armed persons onboard a skiff while underway 104NM southeast of Aden. An exchange of fire occurred during the incident, all crew members reported safe. (Master of Vessel/Clearwater Dynamics)
4. **(U) GULF OF ADEN:** On 15 June at 0735 UTC, a container vessel was attacked by a skiff while underway approximately 14NM south of Yemen. The skiff opened fire and attempted to board, all crew members reported safe. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
5. **(U) SOMALIA:** On 14 June at 0730 UTC, an attempted boarding occurred a cargo vessel while underway 35NM southeast of Xaafuun. The vessel was approached by two boats carrying six persons and repeatedly fired their weapons and ordered the vessel to stop. The vessel's security team was deployed and returned fire, all crew members reported safe. (MSCIO/Clearwater Dynamics)
6. **(U) OMAN:** On 12 June at 2230 UTC, a tanker was attacked and struck by Iranian UAVs while underway 6NM east of Oman. The tanker sustained damage to the portside of the bow, all crew members reported safe. (UKMTO/OPEN SOURCE/Clearwater Dynamics)
7. **(U) OMAN:** On 11 June at 0705 UTC, a tanker was attacked while attempting to bypass the blockade imposed by US forces. The tanker experienced a fire in the engine room, all crew member reported safe. (UKMTO/OPEN SOURCE/Clearwater Dynamics)
8. **(U) OMAN:** On 10 June at 0930 UTC, a Palau-flagged tanker was struck by a missile while attempting to bypass the ongoing blockade imposed by American forces. The tanker was struck in the engine room, resulting in one casualty and two crew members missing. (UKMTO/OPEN SOURCE/Clearwater Dynamics)
9. **(U) GULF OF ADEN:** On 10 June at 0430 UTC, a cargo vessel was attacked by a small craft approximately 88NM southwest of Balhaf, Yemen. An exchange of fire occurred between the six-armed perpetrators and the vessel's armed security team, all crew members reported safe. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
10. **(U) OMAN:** On 08 June, a Palau-flagged tanker experienced a fire onboard approximately 15NM northeast Masirah. The cause of the fire remains unknown, all crew members reported safe. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)

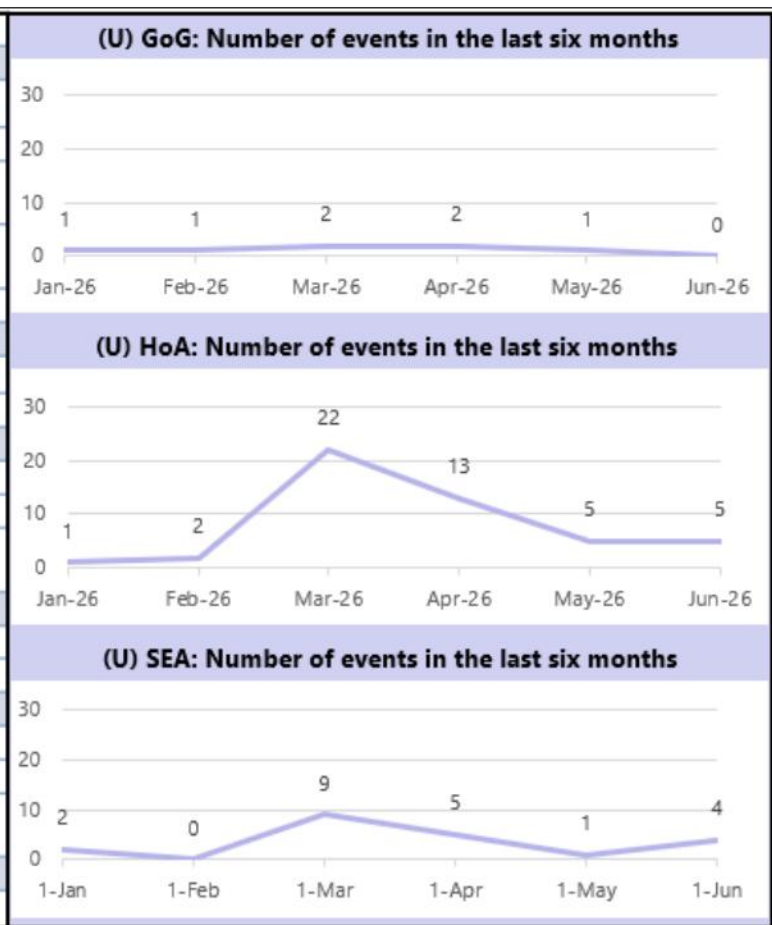

(U) Appendix B: Definitions

(U) In order to promote consistent use of accurate terms of reference, we use the following definitions to describe a range of criminal antishipping activity and impediments to safe navigation in our worldwide reporting and analysis.

- > (U) **Attempted Boarding** – Close approach or hull-to-hull contact with report that boarding paraphernalia were employed or visible in the approaching boat.
- > (U) **Blocking** – Hampering safe navigation, docking, or undocking of a vessel as a means of protest.
- > (U) **Boarding** – Unauthorized embarkation of a vessel by persons not part of its complement without successfully taking control of the vessel.
- > (U) **Fired Upon** – Weapons discharged at or toward a vessel.
- > (U) **Hijacking** – Unauthorized seizure and retention of a vessel by persons not part of its complement.
- > (U) **Kidnapping** – Unauthorized forcible removal of persons belonging to the vessel from it.
- > (U) **Hijacking/Kidnapping Combination** – Unauthorized seizure and retention of a vessel by persons not part of its complement who forcefully remove crew members from vessel when disembarking.
- > (U) **Robbery** – Theft from a vessel or from persons aboard the vessel.
- > (U) **Suspicious Approach** – All other unexplained activity in close proximity of an unknown vessel.
