(U) Worldwide Threat to Shipping (WTS) Report, 17 June – 15 July 2026

16 JULY 2026

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(U) Executive Summary

(U) Scope

(U) The Worldwide Threat to Shipping (WTS) report provides information on threats to merchant vessels, the shipping industry, and other maritime stakeholders worldwide in the last 30 days. This report is produced primarily to inform merchant mariners and naval forces.

(U) Summary:

1. ****LATE REPORT** (U) SINGAPORE STRAIT:** On 04 July at 2100 UTC, a robbery occurred onboard a tanker.
2. ****LATE REPORT** (U) INDONESIA:** On 07 July at 1539 UTC, a robbery occurred onboard a bulk carrier.
3. **(U) OMAN:** On 13 July at 2104 UTC, a tanker was struck by an unknown projectile.
4. **(U) OMAN:** On 13 July, two tankers were struck by Iranian cruise missiles.
5. **(U) OMAN:** On 11 July at 2240 UTC, a container ship was attacked.

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(U) Monthly Incidents by Region

(U) This section lists reports of active violence against shipping, credible threats to shipping, or the potential for a situation to develop into a direct threat to shipping over the past 30 days. Every effort is made to ensure incidents are not double counted. In the event double-counting is detected, or an incident is later found to be different than initially reported, an explanation of the cancellation of the inaccurate report will be made in at least one message prior to dropping the erroneous report.

1. **(U) PERU:** On 18 June at 1305 local time, a robbery occurred onboard a container vessel while anchored at Callao Anchorage. The perpetrators boarded the vessel undetected and stole some ship's properties, all crew members reported safe. (ICC/Clearwater Dynamics)

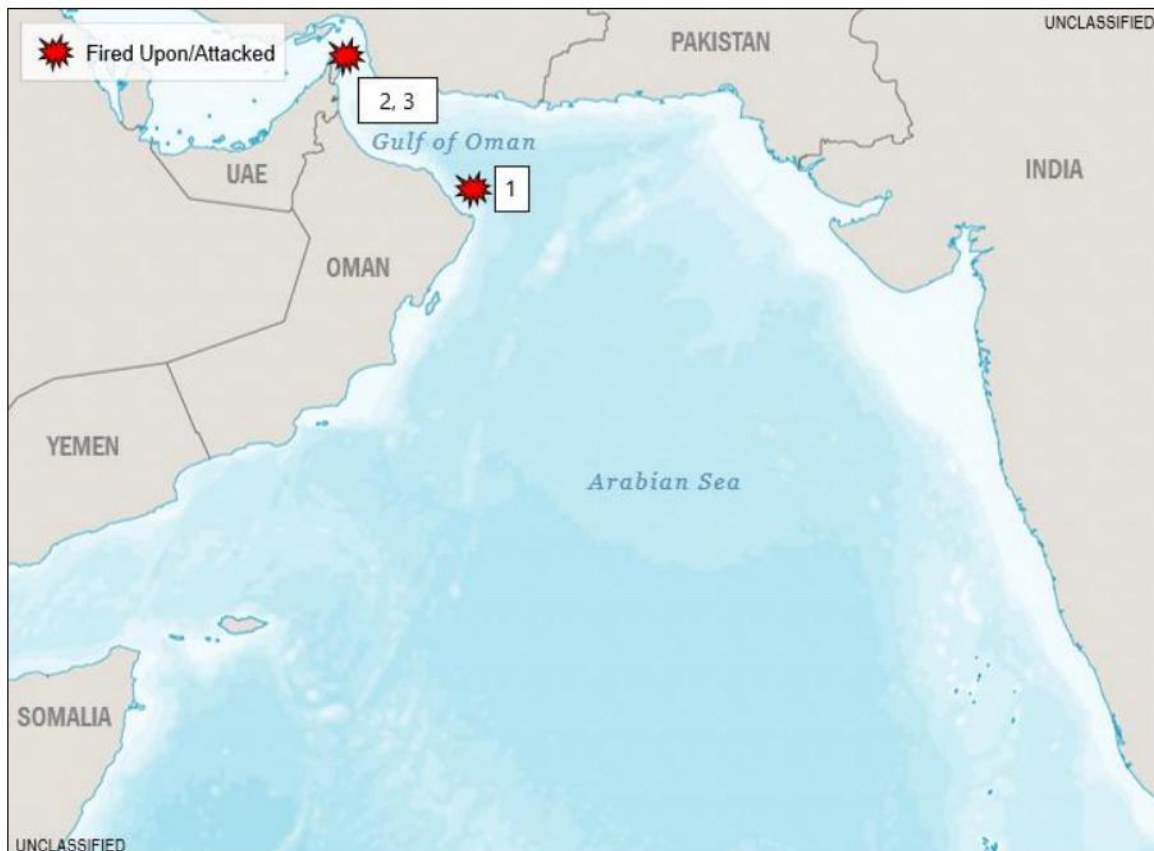
1. ****LATE REPORT** (U) SINGAPORE STRAIT:** On 04 July at 2100 UTC, a robbery occurred onboard a Singaporean-flagged tanker while underway in the Singapore strait. The perpetrators stole engine spares, all crew members reported safe. (IMB/Clearwater Dynamics)
2. ****LATE REPORT** (U) INDONESIA:** On 07 July at 1539 UTC, a robbery occurred onboard a bulk carrier while anchored at Jakarta Anchorage. Two robbers were spotted in the engine room and escaped with engine spares, all crew members reported safe. (IMB/Clearwater Dynamics)
3. **(U) INDONESIA:** On 29 June at 2030 local time, it was reported that robbers boarded an anchored bulk carrier unnoticed. The perpetrators escaped with stolen ship's properties. No further details regarding the stolen items nor the crew safety have been reported. (IMB/Clearwater Dynamics)
4. **(U) SINGAPORE STRAIT:** On 25 June at 0040 local time, an attempted robbery occurred onboard a cargo vessel while underway in the Phillip Channel. The crew spotted three-armed perpetrators. No further information has been released, all crew members reported safe. (IFC/Clearwater Dynamics)
5. **(U) INDONESIA:** On 20 June at 1900 UTC, a robbery occurred onboard a barge under tow off Berakit Island. Three perpetrators boarded the vessel and escaped with stolen items, all crew members reported safe. (ICC/IMB/Clearwater Dynamics)

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6. **(U) MANILA:** On 19 June at 0035 local time, a robbery occurred onboard a Marshall Islands-flagged container vessel while at anchor off MICT Anchorage. The crew spotted the perpetrators on board and raised the alarm. The robbers escaped with stolen ship's stores and equipment, all crew members reported safe. (IFC/Clearwater Dynamics)

(U) PERSIAN GULF

1. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 27 June at 0830 UTC, a tanker was struck by an unknown projectile while transiting in the Strait of Hormuz. The vessel sustained damage to the bridge, all crew members reported safe. (UKMTO/MSCIO/Clearwater Dynamics)
2. **(U) OMAN:** On 25 June at 1410 UTC, a cargo vessel was struck by an unknown projectile 7.5NM southeast of Dahit. The vessel sustained damage to the bridge, all crew members reported safe. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)

(U) INDIAN OCEAN – EAST AFRICA – RED SEA

1. **(U) OMAN:** On 13 July at 2104 UTC, a tanker was struck by an unknown projectile while underway approximately 40NM northeast of Qalhat. The vessel sustained damage to the starboard side of the engine room, all crew members reported safe. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)

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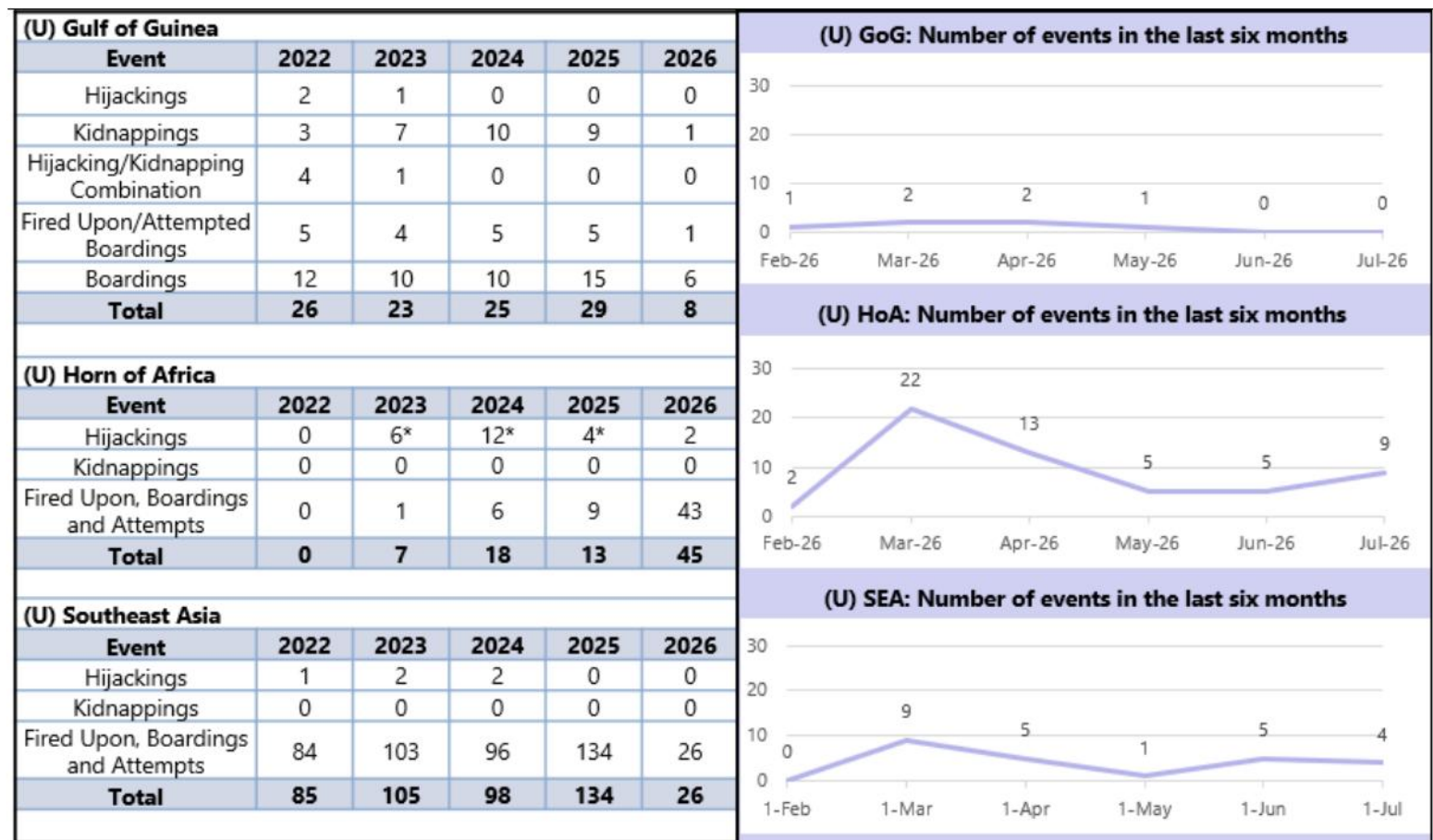
2. **(U) OMAN:** On 13 July, two tankers were targeted and struck by Iranian cruise missiles while transiting in Omani waters in the Strait of Hormuz. Fires broke out onboard the vessels and have since been controlled by the crew. There have been multiple crew casualties and at least one fatality. (CLOSED/Clearwater Dynamics)
3. **(U) OMAN:** On 11 July at 2240 UTC, a container ship was attacked 9NM east of Oman. The vessel sustained damage to the rear and caused a fire to break out onboard. All crew members evacuated the ship onto lifeboats and have since been rescued by local authorities. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
4. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 07 July at 1305 UTC time, UKMTO reported that a tanker had been struck by an unknown Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) while transiting the Strait of Hormuz. The impact caused minor structural damage to the vessel with no casualties nor environmental impacts. The vessel continued to its next port of call. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
5. **(U) INDIAN OCEAN:** On 07 July at 0001 UTC time, UKMTO received a third-party report indicating that a tanker was struck by an unknown projectile while transiting the Strait of Hormuz. The vessel reported sustained structural damage, no casualties nor pollution reported at this time. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
6. **(U) OMAN:** On 06 July at 2119 UTC time, it was reported that a tanker had been struck by an unknown projectile on its port side while traveling southbound. The impact caused a fire onboard the vessel. The Master confirmed there are no casualties nor environmental impacts. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
7. **(U) YEMEN:** On 05 July at 0719 UTC time, UKMTO reported that a cargo vessel issued an alert stating that they were under attack by unknown armed assailants. MSCIO reported the bulk carrier was approached by a skiff and was fired upon. The armed security team on board returned fire, after which the skiff moved away towards a mothership vessel. The vessel and crew are reported safe. (UKMTO/CLOSED/MSCIO/Clearwater Dynamics)
8. **(U) GULF OF ADEN:** On 01 July at 0715 UTC, a boarding occurred onboard a cargo vessel approximately 76NM south of Yemen. One small craft carrying armed perpetrators approached the vessel and opened fire, causing minor damage to the bridge. All crew members reported safe. (UKMTO/MICA/Clearwater Dynamics)
9. **(U) GULF OF ADEN:** On 21 June at 1319 UTC, an attempted boarding occurred to a tanker while underway 50NM southeast of Yemen. A skiff carrying five-armed perpetrators attempted to board the tanker. The tanker conducted evasive maneuvers and the skiff broke off. All crew members reported safe. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
10. **(U) GULF OF ADEN:** On 17 June at 1610 UTC, a vessel was fired upon by two skiffs with an unknown number of armed perpetrators onboard while underway 105NM southeast of Aden. The vessel's security team was deployed and an exchange of fire occurred, one crew member was injured during the incident. (UKMTO/CLOSED/Clearwater Dynamics)

(U) Appendix B: Definitions

(U) In order to promote consistent use of accurate terms of reference, we use the following definitions to describe a range of criminal antishipping activity and impediments to safe navigation in our worldwide reporting and analysis.

- > (U) **Attempted Boarding** – Close approach or hull-to-hull contact with report that boarding paraphernalia were employed or visible in the approaching boat.
- > (U) **Blocking** – Hampering safe navigation, docking, or undocking of a vessel as a means of protest.
- > (U) **Boarding** – Unauthorized embarkation of a vessel by persons not part of its complement without successfully taking control of the vessel.
- > (U) **Fired Upon** – Weapons discharged at or toward a vessel.
- > (U) **Hijacking** – Unauthorized seizure and retention of a vessel by persons not part of its complement.
- > (U) **Kidnapping** – Unauthorized forcible removal of persons belonging to the vessel from it.
- > (U) **Hijacking/Kidnapping Combination** – Unauthorized seizure and retention of a vessel by persons not part of its complement who forcefully remove crew members from vessel when disembarking.
- > (U) **Robbery** – Theft from a vessel or from persons aboard the vessel.
- > (U) **Suspicious Approach** – All other unexplained activity in close proximity of an unknown vessel.
