(U) Worldwide Threat to Shipping (WTS) Report, 05 August – 02 September 2026

3 SEPTEMBER 2026

(U) Executive Summary

(U) Scope

(U) The Worldwide Threat to Shipping (WTS) report provides information on threats to merchant vessels, the shipping industry, and other maritime stakeholders worldwide in the last 30 days. This report is produced primarily to inform merchant mariners and naval forces.

(U) Warnings, Advisories, and Alerts: See Appendix C for active advisories.

(U) Summary:

1. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 31 August at 2000 UTC, a tanker was struck by three unknown projectiles.
2. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 31 August at 2050 UTC, a tanker was attacked.
3. **(U) INDIAN OCEAN:** On 31 August at 1600 UTC, a tanker had an incident with military forces.
4. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 29 August at 2053 UTC, a tanker was struck by an unknown projectile.
5. **** LATE REPORT ** (U) INDONESIA:** On 24 August, a tanker was robbed.
6. **** LATE REPORT ** (U) VIETNAM:** On 23 August at 0106 local time, a bulk carrier was robbed.
7. **** LATE REPORT ** (U) PERU:** On 22 August at 0130 local time, a bulk carrier was robbed.

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(U) Monthly Incidents by Region

(U) This section lists reports of active violence against shipping, credible threats to shipping, or the potential for a situation to develop into a direct threat to shipping over the past 30 days. Every effort is made to ensure incidents are not double counted. In the event double-counting is detected, or an incident is later found to be different than initially reported, an explanation of the cancellation of the inaccurate report will be made in at least one message prior to dropping the erroneous report.

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(U) NORTH AMERICA

(U) No current incidents to report.

(U) CENTRAL AMERICA – CARIBBEAN – SOUTH AMERICA

1. **** LATE REPORT ** (U) PERU:** On 22 August at 0130 local time, IMB reported that a bulk carrier was boarded while at anchor in San Nicolas Anchorage, Peru. Two perpetrators armed with knives were spotted by the duty crew near the forecastle store. The alarm was immediately raised which resulted in the perpetrators escaping with stolen ship's stores. The incident was reported to Port Control. (IMB/Clearwater Dynamics)

(U) ATLANTIC OCEAN AREA

(U) NORTHERN EUROPE – BALTIC

(U) MEDITERRANEAN – BLACK SEA

1. **(U) BLACK SEA:** On 16 August at 1600 LT, a Liberian-flagged tanker was struck by a drone whilst drifting after completing loading operations near CPC Terminal, Novorossiysk, Russia. The vessel sustained a direct hit to the bridge, resulting in communications systems being disabled. All crew members reported safe. (MASTER OF VESSEL/Clearwater Dynamics)
2. **(U) BLACK SEA:** On 05 August, a Guinea-Bissau-flagged cargo vessel and a Liberian-flagged bulk carrier were reportedly struck by unknown projectiles by Russia whilst operating in the Northwestern region of the Black Sea. Fires broke out onboard both vessels following the strikes. A total of one fatality and three casualties were reported. All other crew members were reported safe. (OPEN SOURCE/Clearwater Dynamics)

(U) INDIAN SUBCONTINENT

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(U) WEST AFRICA – GULF OF GUINEA

1. **(U) NIGERIA:** On 11 August, a passenger boat with 22 passengers on board was attacked by sea pirates while transiting within the area of Calabar, Oron, and Ibaka waterways. The boat was intercepted by armed sea robbers after passing Enwang. Nigerian Navy personnel, in coordination with security agencies, recovered the hijacked passenger boat and safely recovered all 22 passengers. (OPEN/Clearwater Dynamics)

(U) EAST ASIA – SOUTHEAST ASIA

1. **** LATE REPORT ** (U) INDONESIA:** On 24 August, a robbery occurred onboard a vessel while berthed at Lubuk Gaung Port, Indonesia. Two perpetrators boarded the vessel and stole generator spare parts while the vessel was loading cargo. A watch helmsman discovered the robbers in the engine room and raised the alarm. The perpetrators fled the stern deck, jumped overboard, and escaped via a small boat. All crew are reported safe. (IFC/Clearwater Dynamics)
2. **** LATE REPORT ** (U) VIETNAM:** On 23 August at 0106 local time, an anchored bulk carrier was robbed at Vung Tau Anchorage, Vietnam. The robbers were able to board the vessel and escape with items from the ships store. The incident was reported to the local authorities. (IMB/Clearwater Dynamics)
3. **(U) PAPUA NEW GUINEA:** On 20 August at 1255 UTC, a French-flagged research vessel was boarded by seven robbers whilst anchored off Wewak, East Sepik Province. The perpetrators boarded the vessel from a motorized banana boat. Personal and professional electronic equipment was reported stolen before the robbers escaped heading east. One crew member sustained minor injuries. (IFC/Clearwater Dynamics)
4. **(U) BANGLADESH:** On 10 August at 1000 UTC, it was reported that a Singapore-flagged tanker had been boarded while berthed at Chattogram Port. The vessel crew reportedly sighted four perpetrators near the port side mid-ship store. The alarm was raised and the perpetrators escaped. All crew are reported safe and some items from the store were stolen. (IFC/Clearwater Dynamics)

(U) PERSIAN GULF

(U) No current incidents to report.

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(U) INDIAN OCEAN – EAST AFRICA – RED SEA



1. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 31 August at 2050 UTC, UKMTO has reported a tanker was attacked while underway in the Strait of Hormuz. Initial reports indicated the incident resulted in two casualties. No environmental impacts have been reported at this time. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
2. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 31 August at 2000 UTC, a tanker was attacked while completing an outbound transit in the Strait of Hormuz. The vessel was struck by three unknown projectiles. No casualties or environmental impacts have been reported at this time. (UKMTO/MICA-CENTER/Clearwater Dynamics)
3. **(U) INDIAN OCEAN:** On 31 August at 1600 UTC, a tanker was involved in an incident with military forces while operating in the Indian Ocean. The Master reported this incident to authorities, who are aware and relevant investigations remain ongoing. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
4. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 29 August at 2053 UTC, a tanker was attacked while transiting 12NM North of Khasab, Oman. The tanker was struck by an unknown projectile while transiting inbound in the Strait of Hormuz. No casualties or environmental impacts are reported currently. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
5. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 25 August at 1730 UTC, the UKMTO reported that a Kuwaiti-flagged tanker was struck by an unknown projectile whilst transiting through the Strait of Hormuz, causing a fire onboard, which has been extinguished. All crew are reported safe, and no environmental impacts have been reported. (UKMTO)

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6. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 24 August at 2024 UTC, the UKMTO reported that a Liberian-flagged tanker was struck by an unknown projectile approximately 9NM northeast of Ash Shishah, UAE. The Master of the ship reported that there was damage to the engine room, which disabled the vessel. All crew are reported safe, and the environmental impact is unknown currently. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
7. **(U) RED SEA:** On 24 August at 0637 UTC, the UKMTO reported that a Saudi Arabian-flagged tanker was struck by an unknown projectile approximately 63NM west of Saudi Arabia, causing a fire on the main deck. All crew are reported safe, and no environmental impact has been reported. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
8. **(U) GULF OF ADEN:** On 20 August, the UKMTO reported that a tanker was hijacked by six-armed perpetrators approximately 136NM east of Al Mukalla, Yemen. The perpetrators are reportedly in control of the vessel and are sailing towards Somalia. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
9. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 18 August at 0135 UTC, the UKMTO reported that a vessel was struck by an unknown projectile whilst conducting an outbound transit of the Strait of Hormuz. The impact caused damage to the engine room and resulted in a crew casualty. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
10. **(U) SOMALIA:** On 17 August at 1136 UTC, the UKMTO reported that a cargo vessel had been hijacked whilst transiting approximately 4NM south of Mareeyo, Somalia. The Company Security Officer reported that eight-armed unauthorized persons boarded the vessel and have taken control. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
11. **(U) BAB-EL-MANDEB:** On 17 August at 1100 UTC, the UKMTO reported that a cargo vessel was struck by multiple unknown projectiles approximately 40NM southeast of Al Mukha, Yemen. The vessel was unmanned at the time of the incident and the damage sustained has resulted in a complete constructive loss of the vessel. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
12. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 15 August at 2200 UTC, the UKMTO reported that a bulk carrier was attacked whilst transiting in the Strait of Hormuz by an unknown projectile. The strike caused damage to the starboard side of the vessel and resulted in a crew casualty. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
13. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 14 August at 2000 UTC, the UKMTO reported that a bulk carrier was attacked whilst transiting in the Strait of Hormuz near Kumzar, Oman. The vessel was struck on the hull by an unknown projectile. All crew members reported safe. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
14. **(U) STRAIT OF HORMUZ:** On 13 August, two Abu Dhabi National Oil Company (ADNOC) tankers were struck by unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV) whilst conducting an outbound transit of the Strait of Hormuz. The vessels sustained minor damage and all crew members reported safe. (Closed/UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
15. **(U) GULF OF OMAN:** On 11 August at 0715 UTC, the UKMTO reported that an incident involving a container ship and military forces has occurred in the Gulf of Oman. There are no reports of casualties or environmental impacts. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)

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16. **(U) OMAN:** On 05 August at 1918 UTC, a tanker heard two explosions while transiting in the Strait of Hormuz, 9NM southeast of Kumzar, Oman. All crew members reported safe. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)
17. **(U) GULF OF ADEN:** On 05 August at 1430 UTC, a tanker heard an explosion in close proximity of the vessel, 95NM southeast of Aden, Yemen. All crew members reported safe. (UKMTO/Clearwater Dynamics)

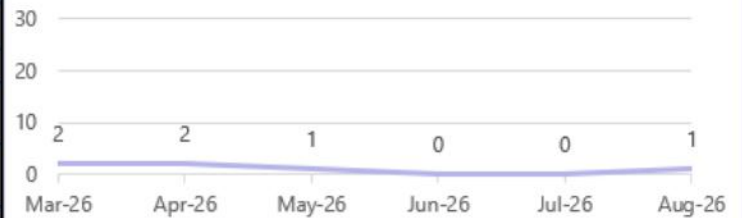

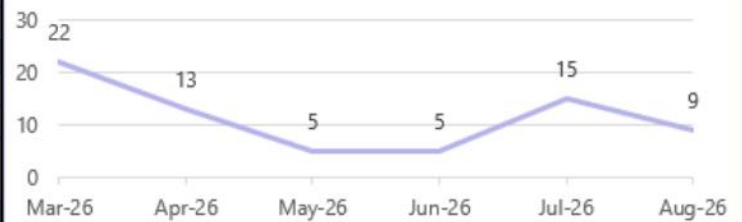

(U) Appendix B: Definitions

(U) In order to promote consistent use of accurate terms of reference, we use the following definitions to describe a range of criminal antishipping activity and impediments to safe navigation in our worldwide reporting and analysis.

- > (U) **Attempted Boarding** – Close approach or hull-to-hull contact with report that boarding paraphernalia were employed or visible in the approaching boat.
- > (U) **Blocking** – Hampering safe navigation, docking, or undocking of a vessel as a means of protest.
- > (U) **Boarding** – Unauthorized embarkation of a vessel by persons not part of its complement without successfully taking control of the vessel.
- > (U) **Fired Upon** – Weapons discharged at or toward a vessel.
- > (U) **Hijacking** – Unauthorized seizure and retention of a vessel by persons not part of its complement.
- > (U) **Kidnapping** – Unauthorized forcible removal of persons belonging to the vessel from it.
- > (U) **Hijacking/Kidnapping Combination** – Unauthorized seizure and retention of a vessel by persons not part of its complement who forcefully remove crew members from vessel when disembarking.
- > (U) **Robbery** – Theft from a vessel or from persons aboard the vessel.
- > (U) **Suspicious Approach** – All other unexplained activity in close proximity of an unknown vessel.
