(U) Worldwide Threat to Shipping (WTS) Report, 24 December –21 January 2026

23 JANUARY 2026

(U) Executive Summary

(U) Scope

(U) The Worldwide Threat to Shipping (WTS) report provides information on threats to merchant vessels, the shipping industry, and other maritime stakeholders worldwide in the last 30 days. This report is produced primarily to inform merchant mariners and naval forces.

(U) Summary:

1. **(U) PHILIPPINES:** On 15 January a robbery occurred onboard a Panama-flagged bulk carrier.

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(U) Monthly Incidents by Region

(U) This section lists reports of active violence against shipping, credible threats to shipping, or the potential for a situation to develop into a direct threat to shipping over the past 30 days. Every effort is made to ensure that incidents are not double-counted. In the event that double-counting is detected, or an incident is later found to be different than initially reported, an explanation of the cancellation of the inaccurate report will be made in at least one message prior to dropping the erroneous report.

(U) CENTRAL AMERICA – CARIBBEAN – SOUTH AMERICA

1. **(U) PERU:** On 29 December at 0608 local time a robbery occurred on board a bulk carrier while anchored at Callao Anchorage. The duty crew reported theft of the ship's forward mooring ropes. All crew were reported safe. (Clearwater Dynamics/IMB)

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(U) WEST AFRICA – GULF OF GUINEA

1. **(U) GABON:** On 11 January at 0235 UTC, a kidnapping occurred onboard a Chinese fishing vessel while underway between Port Gentil and Libreville. Nine crew members were abducted comprising of five Chinese and four Indonesian nationals. The vessel and its three remaining crew members were escorted into Libreville by the Gabonese Military vessel Mendene. (Clearwater Dynamics/CLOSED)
2. **(U) NIGERIA:** On 30 December a kidnapping occurred onboard a civilian passenger boat while underway from Oron, on Ikang waterways. Eight passengers including two children were abducted. All of the abducted individuals were freed and recovered safely by Nigerian Army. (Clearwater Dynamics/CLOSED)

(U) PERSIAN GULF

(U) No current incidents to report.

(U) INDIAN OCEAN – EAST AFRICA – RED SEA

1. **(U) SOMALIA:** On 01 January at 0830 local time, a hijacking of a Chinese-flagged fishing vessel occurred 5nm off the coast of Kulue, Somalia. The hijacked vessel is assessed to be enroute to the Somalian coast to request a ransom. (Clearwater Dynamics/ MSCIO/ EUNAVFOR)

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(U) EAST ASIA – SOUTHEAST ASIA



1. **(U) PHILIPPINES:** On 15 of January a robbery occurred on a Panama-flagged bulk carrier while anchored in Bauan Anchorage, Batangas Bay. The duty crew discovered the robbery during routine rounds. The crew is safe and the ship's property was reported stolen. (Clearwater Dynamics/IFC)
2. **(U) SINGAPORE STRAIT:** On 05 January at 1341 local time, a robbery occurred onboard a barge while being towed by a Singapore-flagged tug in the Eastbound Lane of the Traffic Separation Scheme. The crew is safe and scrap metal was reported stolen. (Clearwater Dynamics/Closed)
3. **(U) SINGAPORE STRAIT:** On 25 December at 1330 local time, a robbery occurred onboard a Singapore-flagged vessel while underway in the Eastbound Lane of the Traffic Separation Scheme. The captain of ship reported nine preparators onboard the vessel. The crew is reported safe and scrap metal was reported stolen. (Clearwater Dynamics/IFC)



(U) Appendix B: Definitions

(U) In order to promote consistent use of accurate terms of reference, we use the following definitions to describe a range of criminal antishipping activity and impediments to safe navigation in our worldwide reporting and analysis.

- > (U) **Attempted Boarding** – Close approach or hull-to-hull contact with report that boarding paraphernalia were employed or visible in the approaching boat.
- > (U) **Blocking** – Hampering safe navigation, docking, or undocking of a vessel as a means of protest.
- > (U) **Boarding** – Unauthorized embarkation of a vessel by persons not part of its complement without successfully taking control of the vessel.
- > (U) **Fired Upon** – Weapons discharged at or toward a vessel.
- > (U) **Hijacking** – Unauthorized seizure and retention of a vessel by persons not part of its complement.
- > (U) **Kidnapping** – Unauthorized forcible removal of persons belonging to the vessel from it.
- > (U) **Hijacking/Kidnapping Combination** – Unauthorized seizure and retention of a vessel by persons not part of its complement who forcefully remove crew members from vessel when disembarking.
- > (U) **Robbery** – Theft from a vessel or from persons aboard the vessel.
- > (U) **Suspicious Approach** – All other unexplained activity in close proximity of an unknown vessel.
